Readying Incoming Students for Excellence is a **FREE** program that will prepare you for your college career at ECC. RISE has three components: English skills, math skills, and a college success skills workshop called ECC and You. Eligibility for the English and math workshops will be determined by your placement test scores while any new student can attend ECC and You. Depending on your placement scores, you may be eligible to attend one, two, or all three workshops.

This project is funded through the US Department of Education Title III Program, Strengthening Institutions. The Federally-provided funds of \$1.73 million represents 81% of total project costs, with the remaining 19% (\$628,399) financed by Erie Community College. The grant period is from October 1, 2005 to October 1, 2010.

Based on placement test scores, students take either the numeric skills or the algebra skills workshop. Both include fifteen hours of instruction in math skills, study skills, and tests taking skills. At the end of the 5-day workshop students are given an opportunity to retake the math skills portion of the placement test.
