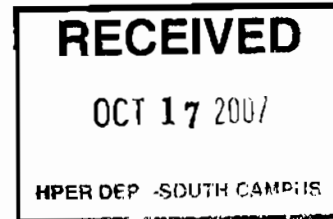

Dear Professor McQuade:


